1. Nomination

3. Selection

Acceptance will be notified within 4 weeks after the application deadline.

Semester dates: 1st (Fall/Winter) semester: end of September 2026 – mid-January 2027

2nd (Spring) semester: February – end of June 2027

Language

All courses are taught in French, even though some teachers are able to interact in English. Therefore, international students are expected to have a minimum level in French (B2) before their arrival in order to follow the courses in the best possible conditions.

Non-French-speaking students are offered French classes during their stay in ebabx: 4h per week with a certified professor in French as a Foreign Language. 2 ECTS may be awarded upon regular attendance.

STUDY PROGRAMS

Bachelor Art or Design

Students chose 1 "parcours" (pathway) in art or design dedicated to their personal project, at least 1 module, 1 theoretical course, 1 language course, a course of history of arts or a 2nd theoretical course.

Master Art or Design

Students chose 1 "plateforme" (platform) in art or design dedicated to their personal project, at least 1 seminar or working group, 1 language course.

- . Credits
 - [ECTS](#) (European credits transfer system): up to 30 ECTS per semester
 - . Fees
 - International students coming from a partner institution (with which an interinstitutional agreement is running) do not pay enrolment fees.
